Action Taken Report on Parents' Feedback: 2021 and 2022

To understand the attitude of the parents' towards the institution, parents' feedbacks were collected for the session 2020-2021 and 2021-2022. The IQAC had collected 84 numbers of feedbacks in the session 2020-2021 and 133 numbers feedback from parent in the session 2021-2022. From the analysis of feedbacks it is found that most of the parents were satisfied with the college facilities. It is also found that 17.86 and 4.51% parents were not satisfied with the infrastructure facilities like library, computer Lab. Canteen and other campus facilities of the college respectively. 3.57% and .75% parents were also not satisfied with the co-curricular activities of the college. 2.38% parents were not satisfied with the quality of academic resources of the college and 15.29% and 1.50% parents were also not satisfied with the college activities on placement respectively.

The IQAC and college authority had taken the suggestions of parents seriously and some suitable actions were taken to satisfy the expectations of parents and students. The actions are-

- The central library of the college was improved with reputed books and journals. Separate reading room for teachers and students were constructed and the library was digitalized.
- Computer lab. of the college was strengthened by including more computers with internet facilities.
- The Canteen of the college has been decided to improve in the near future.
- Campus facilities for students have been increased. A rain harvesting water system had installed. The girl's common room had constructed keeping in mind the problems of girls. A ramp was constructed for specially disable students.
- For the enhancement beauty of college, the college has maintained a green environment with an Orchid plantation site.
- For encouragement to students for participation in sports an indoor stadium was constructed and the play ground of the college has developed with a green gallery.
 - From 2022, the IQAC has organized a cultural programme "OITIJAR ADIN" every year for cultural development of students.
 - The Department of Assamese has organized a seven days workshop on "BIHU" from 2022.
